

Curbside Garbage/Trash Guidelines for the Unincorporated Areas of JEFFERSON PARISH AND THE TOWN OF JEAN LAFITTE

Residential Services

Garbage collection services are provided to residences and small businesses with active water meters that are being billed for garbage collection. Vacant lots do not pay garbage fees; therefore, garbage/trash in front of vacant lots will not be collected.

Please refer to the map and chart below to find the scheduled pick up days in your area for twice pr week household garbage, and once/week collection of large bulky waste, white goods and used automobile/pick-up truck tires.

Garbage: Jefferson Parish provides for the unlimited collection of containerized household garbage and trash twice per week. Each container and contents shall weigh no more than 75 lbs.

Small Bulky Waste Items including bicycles, toys, containerized leaves, grass clippings and bundled and neatly stacked yard waste (small tree limbs, shrubs) are collected once per week, usually on the second scheduled garbage collection day. These items must not exceed 4 feet in length, 2 feet in diameter or weigh more than 75 lbs. Small pieces of concrete less than 6 in. x 6 in. must be containerized.

Large Bulky Waste Items weighing between 75 and 400 pounds and measuring between 4 and 6 feet in length (large tree limbs, large pieces of concrete, automobile engines drained of fluids, bulky furniture) are collected once per week.

White goods (large appliances) are collected once per week (limit 4 per address per collection).

Tires including small automotive and passenger truck tires are collected once per week. (limit 4 tires per household per week).

Large bulky items, white goods and tires will be picked up on one of your two regular collection days according to the schedule outlined below. On the east bank, these items are collected on your first scheduled collection day. On the west bank, these items are collected on your second collection day. Questions regarding the collection of large bulky items, white goods and tires can be directed to the Dept. of Environmental Affairs at 731-4612.

Standards

- Garbage should be placed curbside on a Parish servitude immediately in front of one's own property and should not be placed curbside for collection any sooner than 4:00 pm on the day preceding your regular collection day. Emptied containers must be removed from the curb by noon on the day immediately following the collection day.
- Garbage must be containerized in cans (with lids) that are no less than 20 gallons or greater than 35 gallons or in sealed plastic (1.5 mil gauge) bags. Fifty-five (55) gallon drums, paper bags and plastic grocery bags will not be accepted. Containers should be constructed of hard metal or plastic, be watertight and leak proof, with removable lids. The combined weight of container and contents shall not exceed 75 pounds. Bag capacity shall not exceed 30 gallons and filled weight can not exceed 75 pounds.
- All loose debris such as trash and yard waste, including leaves and grass clippings, construction debris, sheet rock, saw dust, etc., must be containerized.
- Bins, receptacles or other containers of a permanent nature above ground shall not be kept, constructed or maintained on Parish property between any sidewalk or private property line and the roadway edge or curb within the Parish

Multifamily Residential

- The owners of multifamily structures (4 or more units) should provide bulky waste containers for the storage and disposal of solid wastes generated by the occupants of said residences unless they are granted a hardship special permit from the director of the Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement. If a hardship special permit is granted and a multifamily structures pays Jefferson Parish for curbside garbage collection, the same services and standards listed above apply except for the following requirement:
- Owners of multi-family structures are responsible for furnishing and maintaining at least one hard plastic garbage container (30-35 gallons) for each dwelling unit in the structure, and the combined weight of container and contents shall not exceed 75 lbs. The owners must also permanently mark each container with the address and number of the dwelling unit for which it is intended in characters at least 6" high by 4" wide. All solid waste, with the exception of bulky waste or yard waste, generated by residents of multifamily structures must be placed in cans.

Small Businesses

Small business collection is governed by the same services and standards listed above with the following exceptions:

- Small businesses receiving curbside collection shall be limited to no more than five (5) containers per collection day per business unit.
- Bulky waste, white goods and tires will not be removed from small businesses. These materials may be brought to the Jefferson Parish Landfill or to the nearest Trash Drop-off Site; however, a disposal fee will be charged.

Trash Drop-Off Sites

The following drop-off sites are available free of charge to residents of unincorporated Jefferson parish and Lafitte. This is because the cost of operating these drop-off sites is included in their

monthly garbage fee. Residents of Jefferson Parish municipalities will be charge a fee to use these drop-off sites as the cost of operating these sites is not included in their monthly garbage fee.

All residents using the trash drop off site must show proof of Parish residency in the form of a valid Louisiana State Driver's License.

All commercial users will be charged a fee to use these sites.

The fee for residents living in Jefferson Parish municipalities other than Lafitte and for all commercial users is:

\$14 for pick-up trucks
\$20 for trailers

Waste Management may direct contractors and residents to the Jefferson Parish Landfill for disposal depending on space constraints and the size of the vehicle. For vehicles hauling trailers, the total combined length of the vehicle plus the trailer may not exceed 25 feet. Anything longer than this will be directed to an area landfill. These sites can not accommodate dump trailers. Residents are reminded that these sites are self-service. Debris must be manually unloaded into roll-off containers.

Used automotive fluids and car batteries may be disposed only at these two locations.
Automotive fluids including transmission fluid and brake fluid must be placed in the used oil tank. Gasoline should be placed in the used antifreeze container. Residents are limited to 5 gallons of fluids per day and 2 car batteries per month.

Waste tires are accepted at David Dr., Lapalco, and Lafitte sites only (limit 5 tires per resident per day).

All residents using the trash drop off site must show proof of Parish residency in the form of a valid Louisiana State Driver's License.

Recycling Update

Collection of recyclables in Jefferson Parish and Lafitte has been suspended until further notice. Recycling fees have also been suspended indefinitely.

In the interim, residents may bring to recyclables to the following locations:
