- 4) the desirability and/or need for an independent source of revenue for the operations and functions of an Office of Inspector General to allow said office to function independently from other governmental agencies which may be subject to the office's scrutiny; and
- 5) recommended ways to legally ensure the independent operations and funding of the Office of Inspector General.
